



- Political majority, right wing: M, C, FP, KD






Why the Greenest City?






1995 - 97 successful co-operation with the Swedish Society for Nature Conservation.

Vision


We have the vision of a fossil fuel free Växjö, where our energy consumption does not lead to any climate change.

- to use energy efficiently.




Fossil Fuel Free Växjö

- Solar panels on City Hall








